BIOGRAPHY OF DIANNE DOUGLAS

Dianne Douglas is an elder, youth leader, and the Clerk of Session at St. Mark's Presbyterian Church, Malton (in Mississauga). She is Deputy Clerk of the Presbytery of Brampton and served as Moderator of the Presbytery for 2014 – 2015. She has served on numerous Presbytery Committees, including being appointed as an Assessor Elder to a Brampton congregation, serving for almost eight years, seven years as Clerk of the Assessor Session.

Dianne is active in the Mississauga community, including being a committed member of the Malton Community Festival for 15 years, and is completing her final year (of four), as Chair of the Board of Directors of the Festival. She also serves as Vice President of the Board of Directors of Punjabi Community Health Services (PCHS), which reaches out to all in need of physical and mental health services in the Region of Peel - the communities of Mississauga, Brampton and Caledon. Additional sites are (or are in the process of being) established in Ottawa, Vaughan, North York, Scarborough and Milton, Ontario; Calgary, Alberta; and Punjab, Pakistan.

Dianne's career is centred in Toronto and Mississauga in sales and marketing. Dianne grew up in Sarnia, and returns often to spend time with family.
